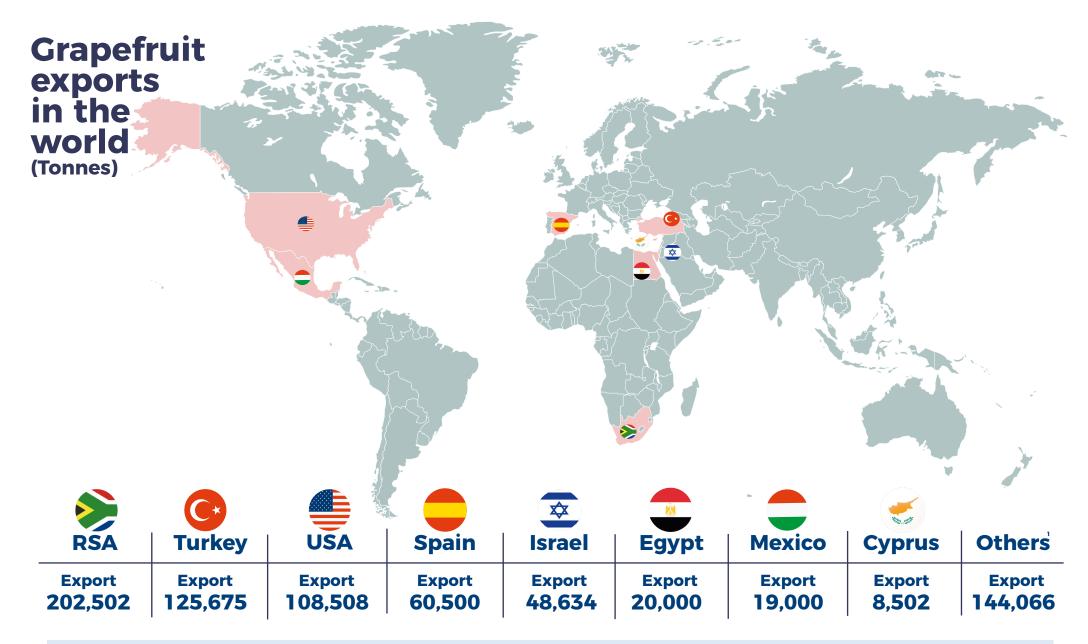

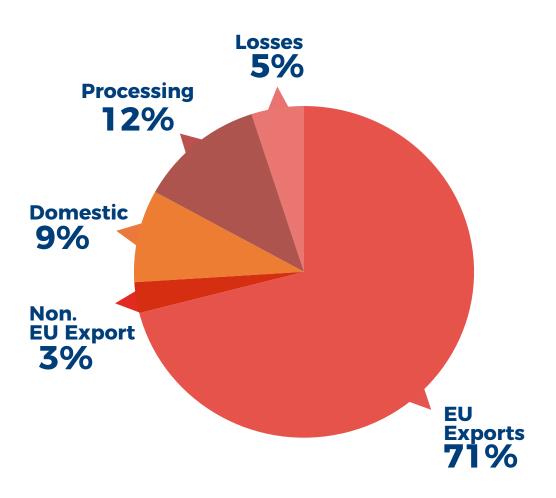

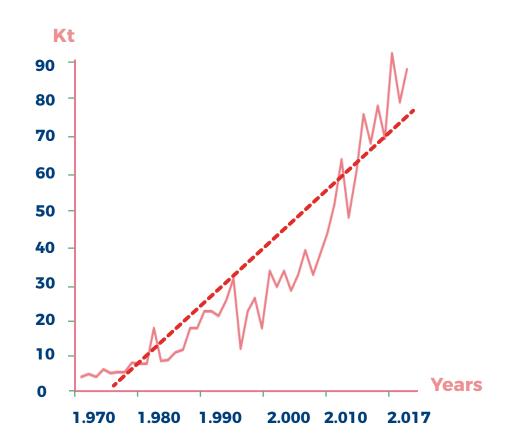

Spanish Grapefruit Production Trend(1970 - 2017)

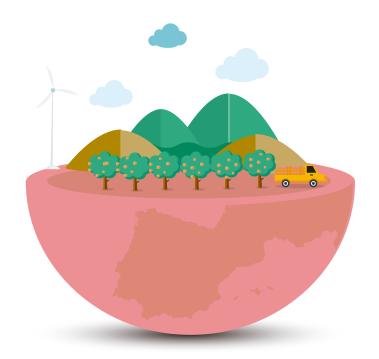
